

The Business Times Budding Artists Fund Application Form

Managed by The RICE Company Limited, The Business Times Budding Artists Fund (BT BAF), which was launched by the then-The Old Parliament House Limited and adopted by The Business Times in 2005, originated from a conviction that no child with strong interest and potential in the arts should be denied of the opportunity to develop his or her talents due to a lack of financial resources.

Eligibility

The following applicants are eligible for BT BAF:

- - a Singapore citizen or Permanent Resident
 - the family's gross monthly household income does not exceed \$2500 or \$625 per capita (whichever is lower)
 - living in a 4-room HDB flat or smaller
 - aged between 5 and 19
 - full-time student receiving formal education
- or
- a Singapore citizen or Permanent Resident aged between 5 and 19 residing in a welfare home or a similar organisation for the less privileged.

Procedure

To apply for the two-year arts training programmes sponsored by BT BAF, please ensure that the application form is filled in accurately and completely. This application form must be endorsed by the parent/guardian of applicants who are aged 18 and below. A non-refundable administrative fee of \$21.40 (including GST) is payable per successful registration per child. The completed form must be accompanied by the following documents (photocopy):

- Birth certificate / NRIC of applicant
 - Supporting certificates/portfolio/testimonials of applicants (for those with previous experiences in the arts) [if any]
- AND
- Latest payslip of all family members (in the same household)
 - Supporting documents of family members (in the same household) (e.g. from employer / retrenchment letter / CDC / CPF / IRAS income tax return / financial assistance schemes)
- OR
- Endorsement by the child's school/welfare organisation (please see Page 2)

Rules and Regulations

- Funding is limited to a maximum period of 2 years only.
- Beneficiaries who are deemed by the management of BTBAF to show strong artistic potential and talent must re-apply to receive funding beyond the 2 years.
- A notice of acceptance will be sent to all successful applicants. Applicants are allowed to attend the arts training programmes sponsored by BT BAF only if they are deemed to have met the eligibility criteria of BT BAF.
- All beneficiaries must display commitment to the sponsored trainings and attain **at least 90% attendance** for all the lessons enrolled to continue receiving funding by BT BAF for the next term.
- Beneficiaries who are unable to attend the sponsored trainings with good reason, due to a medical condition, or important school or special religious events (e.g. examinations), are to provide us with **official documentation** in advance, wherever possible. Please note that attendance at private functions such as birthday celebrations or participation in one-off special events (e.g. marathons, church-organised leisure trips/tours, or workshops) not organised by BT BAF/LAA cannot be considered as good reasons for non-attendance.
- Funding for beneficiaries who are **absent for 2 training sessions, with no good reason and notice given one week in advance**, will cease and a notification will be sent.
- Beneficiaries who have been terminated from BTBAF will have to go through an appeal process should they wish to continue with trainings sponsored by BTBAF. The appeal process will be in the following order:

A penalty equivalent to the cost of training a student for each training session he/she missed must be paid.

A letter of appeal must be submitted to BT BAF. The letter is subjected to the approval of the BT BAF Board of Trustees. Applicants are **not** allowed to attend any training session until the appeal has been approved.

- The management of BT BAF reserves the right to cease funding for beneficiaries.
